- ▶ **Archaeology and Ancient Near East (Ancient Near East section)** - Assyriology (emphasis on the history of the first millennium BCE)
- ▶ **Comparative Literature** - Open
- ▶ **Buddhist Studies**- Buddhism in all of its diverse historical, religious, philosophical, and literary forms, with special interest in Tibetan Buddhism and in other topics that are not currently covered in our curriculum
- ▶ **History** - History of Europe or North America in the early or late modern periods
- ▶ **Hebrew Language**- Mishnaic Hebrew and Medieval Hebrew (Middle Period 7th-18th century)
- ▶ **Asian Studies** - Premodern China
- ▶ **Linguistics (Generative track)** - phonology
- ▶ **Jewish History and Contemporary Jewry** - History of The Jews in Eastern Europe in the Early Modern Period (1500-1850).
- ▶ **History of Art** - Classical Art or Global Renaissance and Early Modern Art (14th to 18th centuries)
